## How do you register?

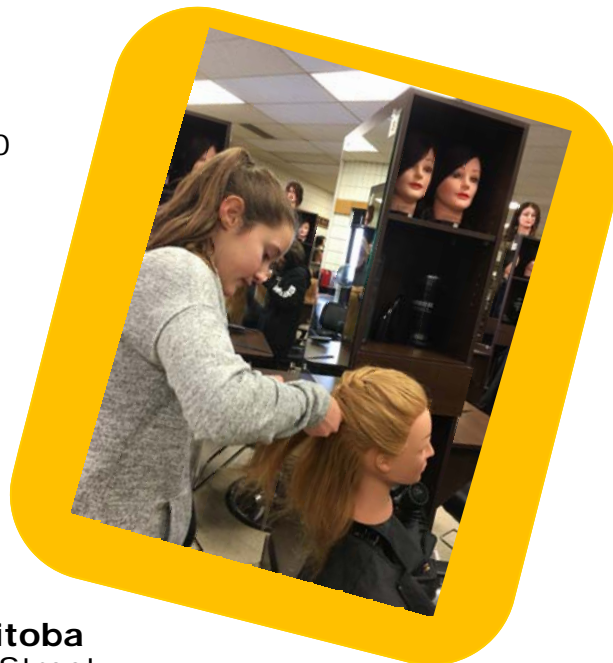
