

Cuts, colours, shampoos, rinses and styles hair.




PARTSPERSON

MACHINIST


Cut and shape metal using controlled equipment to make precisely sized metal products.

AIRCRAFT MAINTENANCE JOURNEYPERSON


Service and maintain aircrafts.


AGRICULTURAL EQUIPMENT TECHNICIAN




TECHNOLOGY

ESSENTIAL SKILLS



Technical skills are also referred to as "hard skills." They are acquired through practice and learning. They assist to complete a job or task.

Numeracy:

how workers, students and people use numbers.

Oral Communication:

use of speech and to give and exchange thoughts and information.

Working with others:

how employees work with others to carry out tasks.

Continuous Learning:

workers/individuals participate in ongoing learning of skills, upgrading and acquiring more information about tasks.

Reading Text:

reading material that is in the form of sentences and paragraphs.

Writing:

involves writing texts and in documents, including typing on a computer.

Thinking:

engaging in the process of evaluating ideas or information to reach a rational decision.

Document Use:

tasks that involve different ways information is displayed such as words, numbers, lines, colours and/or shapes. Ex) graphs, tables, blueprints.

Digital:

tasks that involve the use of a digital instrument or software.
