ADAPTABILITY

We use adaptability to achieve our goals when expected or unexpected change occurs, by planning, staying focused, and overcoming obstacles.

Why this skill is important

Things don't always go according to plan, so it's important for us to be flexible and adaptable to succeed when things change in our lives.



READING

Your ability to find, understand, and use information presented through words, symbols, and images.

Why this skill is important

Reading helps you to understand and interpret the meaning within the text.



COLLABORATION

Collaboration allows us to work in a team or group to reach a common goal.

Why this skill is important

Strong collaboration skills help you build and maintain positive relationships with others, in school, at work and in other parts of your life.



WRITING

Your ability to share information using written words, symbols, and images.

Why this skill is important

We write to communicate ideas and information to other people.



COMMUNICATION

The act of giving, receiving, and sharing information - in other words, talking or writing, and listening or reading.

Strong communication skills help you share information in a way that others can clearly understand.



CREATIVITY & INNOVATION

DIGITAL

NUMERACY

Your ability to find, understand, use, and report mathematical information presented through words, numbers, symbols, and graphics.

Your ability to identify, propose solutions, and make decisions.

Strong problem-solving skills will help you gather the right information, identify, and solve problems, and make better decisions.

The +1 represents the Technical Skills necessary for skilled trade and technology careers. Technical Skills relate to expertise someone possesses that assist in the completion of a job or task. In general, these are abilities acquired through practice and learning.
