Registration is required for this challenge and closes February 19th. Maximum 100 registrations will be accepted. You will receive a Braiding Challenge kit with

everything you need to participate.

Contest starts March 15th and ends March 21st, 2021 at 12:00 p.m.

Contest will be judged in three age groups: Grade K-4 / Grade 5-8 / Grade 9-12. Each age group will have 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place winners. 1st place-\$75, 2nd place-\$50, 3rd place-\$25. All winners will receive Amazon e-gift cards.

Steps to Enter:

- 1. Visit the website: <u>https://hairstylingeducationalbuzz.ca/videos/</u> and click on the Student Section.
- 2. Click on Videos.
- 3. View the videos for your age group:

K-4 contestants view videos: A) Block D-D.1 Visible braid • B) Block D-D.1 Rope braid • C) Block D.33 Fishtail braid.

Grade 5-8 contestants view videos: A) Block D - Draping visible braid • B) Block D-D.1 Rope braid • C) Block D-D.17- 3D Invisible braid.

Grade 9-12 view videos: A) Block D-D.17 3D Invisible braid • B) Block D-D.25 3D Rope (round) braid • C) Block D-D.26 Waterfall braid.

- 4. Perform each braid individually and take two photos of each braid once it is completed. Ensure the background is a contrasting color (For example if hair swatch is dark, the background should be white) and that the photos show the entire strand.
- 5. Please submit your name and grade details and your photos to skillsmb@skillscanada.com, no later than March 21st at 12:00 pm.

Photos will be judge by a Red-Seal hairstylist.
