

Graphic T-Shirt Design Challenge

The challengers are required to create their own graphic t-shirt! Each challenger will be judged on visual design and plans!

Registration is required for this challenge and closes January 8th – Maximum of 100 registrations will be accepted.

Contest will be judged in three age groups: Grade K-4 / Grade 5-8 / Grade 9-12. Each age group will have 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place winners. 1st place-\$75, 2nd place-\$50, 3rd place-\$25. All winners will receive Amazon e-gift cards.



Challenge Materials

White cotton t-shirt and fabric markers will be provided by Skills Manitoba

• Paper • Scissors • Tape • Camera

Challenge Rules

- 1. Using paper, draw out your graphic design. Take a photo.
- 2. Using the paper with completed design make the necessary cuts to create a stencil. Take a photo (this will allow you to later transfer the design to the t-shirt)
- 3. Your design must be a minimum of 5 inches wide and 5 inches tall in size.
- 4. Transfer the design to the t-shirt using the stencil that you created.
- 5. Use the fabric markers provided to color your design, use a minimum of 3 different colors.
- 6. Make sure to follow the legend below to see how you will be graded.
- 7. Bonus marks if your graphic design has a skilled trade or technology theme.
- 8. Once your graphic design t-shirt is finished, take a photo of your finished t-shirt.
- 9. Please send your name, grade level and all photos or documents to skillsmb@skillscanada.com, no later than February 7th at 12:00 p.m.
