
How do I Sign In to Google Classroom?



1. Go to classroom.google.com and click Go to Classroom.




2. Enter the preassigned *skillsmanitoba* email account for your Classroom account and click Next.




STEP 1: Click on the Competition Title (once you enter to Classroom)




