- 2. Challengers must submit a design blue print for their coaster, including measurements and design features, as well as a photo of their creation.
- 3. Each challenger must find a way to make a unique and creative design for their coaster using different colours and patterns. Depending on your grade level you will be scored according to how many colours you can use for your design.
