CONTEST NAME: NAIL TECHNOLOGY

CONTEST NO: 30

LEVEL: INTEGRATED

NOTE: 2 competitors per school, maximum 10 competitors **CONTEST LOCATION:** RRC Polytech, Notre Dame Campus – North Gym

CONTEST START TIME AND DURATION:

PURPOSE OF CHALLENGE:

This competition aims to showcase and elevate the skills, creativity, and professionalism of nail technicians. It provides a platform for competitors to demonstrate their expertise in sculptured nail application and creative nail design. Through rigorous assessment by industry experts, this competition not only celebrates outstanding talent but also sets high standards, inspire continued education, and highlight emerging trends. Ultimately, they contribute to the advancement and recognition of the beauty and wellness industry while demonstrating professionalism and complying with occupational health and safety.

Nail Technology Criteria

Please review the attached information prior to the competition

Competitors will be judged on the following for all competitions:

Sanitation, ethics, professional dress, attitude, behavior, conduct with model, posture, technique, application, finishing and total look.

Skills and Knowledge to be tested

Sculptured French White Gel Extensions in a "Stiletto" shape

Product application and placement of primer, white gel, builder, and topcoat. Competitor should place the form in the correct position to create strength, curvature, and balance of enhancement. Stiletto nail must be a minimum measurement of three on the aluminum form. The smile line should be even to the sidewalls with a crisp line. Application of building gel will be even, smooth and include the correct placement of apex on the nail plate. When filing the nail, competitor will not cause stress or trauma to the surrounding skin of the nail plate. *See pg. 5

Red Gel Polish Application

Competitors are required to apply a bold red gel polish to nine fingers, leaving one ring finger unpolished. Application must include base, color, and topcoat of gel polish. The competitor will demonstrate professional application with full and even coverage to the nail plate. Clean up of red polish is <u>not</u> <u>permitted</u>.

Free Hand Nail Art

On the unpolished ring finger, the competitor will create a hand-painted nail art representation of one of these seasons—spring, summer, autumn, or winter—without any three-dimensional decorations. The design will continue from the ring finger, across the back of the hand, using any chosen art medium. All artwork must be hand painted and free from any embellishments. Competitors are responsible for supplying their own tools and materials for the freehand nail and hand design. *See pg. 5 for example. Images may <u>NOT</u> be used during competition.

EQUIPMENT, TOOLS, AND MATERIALS TO BE SUPPLIED BY COMPETITOR:

- Manicure table (table lamp permitted), chairs with backs, small garbage can with lid or bag to seal off all vapors * no other equipment to be used
- UV/LED Lamp and 10ft. power cord
- Acetone, polish remover, alcohol, hand sanitizer, disinfecting agents for surfaces
- Implements needed to perform nail prep
- Orangewood sticks, Gibson towels
- All brushes and nail art mediums to complete Seasonal Fusion nail and hand artwork
- PPE-facial mask, eye protection, gloves, and appropriate footwear

MATERIALS TO BE SUPPLIED BY SKILLS:

Gel Products to be sponsored by L'Moor. The following Light Elegance product items will be provided at the competition for competitors. * Competitors will not be able to bring any other gel product or files/buffers on the competition floor for the application of artificial nails.

Rules and Requirements/Worksite Safety:

- All competitions will take place on live models. Competitors are responsible for supplying their own model and for the well-being of their model. <u>Models must be dressed in black</u>.
- Competitors must provide <u>all</u> necessary equipment and supplies needed to perform the competition task.
- To ensure compliance with the rules and regulations, all models will be examined by a scrutineer at the start of each competition category. (NO PREP WORK ALLOWED).
- Models' natural nails must not be longer than number one on the paper form. No tools maybe used to assist in the completion of sculptured gels.
- No competitor shall continue to work on his or her model once the competition has ended. This does not include cleaning and presentation. Once the competition has ended, an additional 5 minutes will be designated for post-service sanitation and presentation/display.
- The following are <u>not</u> allowed for the nail art competition: decals (including striping), 3D nail art, foils, stencils, stamps, nail pens, etc. Choice of tools/brushes may be used.
- <u>Note to all Competitors:</u> Competitors must always demonstrate safety throughout the competition and in the competition area. Competitors must wear safety equipment where applicable. Competitors must show concern for their client/model throughout the competition.
- Any infraction or violation of the competition rules will result in point penalties or disqualification according to judges and /or chairs.

Note: If you are in doubt about any other tools or equipment you wish to use, check with the chair of the committee prior to the competition date or at orientation

General Competition Rules

- All competitors will attend a mandatory orientation meeting prior to the start of the competition. 8:00-8:30 am. Failure to attend the mandatory orientation will lead to disqualification.
- All students <u>must</u> wear a professional uniform with <u>no</u> school logo on it. See pg. 5
- Competitors who require clarification on instruction during the contest must address their questions to a Provincial Technical Chair or designate.
- Competitors are not permitted to talk to persons who are not located within the contest area.
- During the competition, competitors are allowed to go to the restrooms, only after informing a PTC chair. Escorts to the restroom will be at the discretion of the Provincial Technical Chair or designate.
- Interpreters will be allowed to access the contest site if previous arrangements have been made with the Provincial Technical Chair of designate.
- Competitors must follow workplace safety rules and regulations as outlined during orientation. (Nail Technology competitors must have dust masks).
- Access to each contest site is reserved for the Provincial Technical chair or designates, judges, competitors, and individuals that have been granted permission from the Provincial Technical chair or designate.
- All competitors shall allow the Skills Manitoba organization to take and publish photos of those individual competitors.
- There must be a minimum of five registered competitors for each category. If there are less than five registered competitors, Skills Manitoba delegates will re-evaluate the competition.
- No competitor shall begin work until the start time is announced.
- Skills Manitoba will make every effort to accommodate contestants with special needs. Please contact the Skills Manitoba office for details.

<u>Note to all Competitors:</u> Competitors must always demonstrate safety throughout the competition and in the competition area. Competitors must wear safety equipment where applicable. Competitors must show concern for their client/model throughout the competition.

15 minutes	Pre-service Setup, Model is greeted & seated. Consultation is performed with model.
	Service is explained to model.
	Treatment area is prepared and all equipment, products and tools to complete
	sculptured gel extensions with French gel. Model is greeted and seated. Consultation
	form is filled out with the model. Competitor verbally explains the service that is going to
	be performed
3 minutes	Checkpoint for Judges
2.50 hours	Sculpture Gel Extension with French Gel
	<u>Nail Prep</u> -correctly files nails into even shape, gently pushes back and removes cuticle, gently buffs surface of nail to remove all shine and cleans nails with cleaner.
	<u>Forms</u> - sits flush under natural nails' free edge from front and side view, ensures no gaps between nail and the form. Form should be carefully pinched to create even arch.
	Bonding Agent-thin layer applied on the natural nail, not the cuticle, and cures in the light. <u>Perfect White</u> -applies layer on the form and natural nail to a minimum of the three line on the form and cleans the white lines prior to placing in light. Smile lines will be even, crisp, symmetrical and consistent on each nail.
	<u>Builder</u> - applies builder to the natural nail to create balanced C-Curve, thin around cuticles and free edge. Product thickness (apex) and arch (stress) of nail is correctly placed for the length and shape of nail.
	<u>Sealant</u> -applies evenly with full coverage over the nail extension ensuring smoothness of application. Removes tacky layer to reveal shiny coat of sealant that has not flooded in the sidewalls or cuticles.
	Workmanship
	<u>Filing</u> -competitor applies facial mask prior to filing, uses file following the curves of the nail, files all areas of the nail plate, does not cause friction heat on the nail plate, does not cause
	trauma to the surrounding skin or cuticle
	<u>Finishing Work</u> -nails are shaped uniformly into stiletto form, surface of nails is smooth without etch marks, thickness and length are correct for competition, free edges are smooth, balanced and finished
	Professionalism
	Implements are clean and in good working condition, containers are closed when not in use,
	does not use fingers to remove dust, competitor does not have excessive dust on self or model,
	maintains organized workstation, maintains professional conduct
	Appearance- clean professional uniform, black nonslip professional closed shoes with black
	socks, all hair tied back away from face and off the collar, competitor must not have jewelry and have short, manicured, non-polished nails.
