1. Only ONE pin design per student can be submitted for consideration.
2. Electronic files will only be accepted in PDF format. File name should include the student's first and last name, contest and school name (e.g. Anna Smith-Pin Contest-Winnipeg School).
3. Please note that due to the nature of pin production and converting artistic concepts into workable lapel pins in metal, submitted designs will be altered and adapted by Skills Manitoba for the final product.
4. Submitting design concepts for this contest authorizes Skills Manitoba to produce the winning design for its intended purposes. Top finalists may be contacted to provide a working file of their design. Winner's final design and name may be published on social media, printed materials, etc.
5. The winning design concept will be reproduced and used as the official pin for Team Manitoba to wear at the Skills Canada National Competition.
6. This is an individual event. No teams.

PIN DESIGN SPECIFICATIONS

1. Designs can be created on a computer. Design entries must be submitted in two pages. Page one being a full colour 8½" x 11" size of your design. Page two to include a 1" x 1" scaled copy of the design. This assists in determining if the design can be easily replicated to a 1" x 1" sized pin along with the student's name, school name, grade/year, email, phone number, and a brief description of your design and how it represents Manitoba.
2. The design can have a maximum of 3 colours plus the metal of the pin in gold or silver. Black and white are considered colours. The metal pin material is not considered one of the three colours, but will appear at the edge of your design as the border and the channel separating the colours throughout.
3. Designs MUST incorporate one of the following words, for example: Skills Manitoba, Skills MB, Mani-toba, Toba, Team MB, etc. and must be inspired by the Province of Manitoba.
4. Any lettering must be clearly legible at 1". A minimum of 2mm for lettering is required. Arial Narrow is the recommended font for visibility.

ELIGIBILITY

ANY Manitoba student in grades 9 to 12 or post-secondary education (includes private, public, etc.) from ANY program (does not have to be a skilled trades or technology program, could be an English or Geography student for example) may participate in this contest.
