Ultimately, they contribute to the advancement and recognition of the beauty therapy profession while demonstrating professionalism and complying with occupational health and safety.

A mark of **70% or higher** must be scored by the gold medalist in the Aesthetics Competition to attend the Skills Canada National Competition.

Contest Description

Facial

***Sponsored by L'Moor: Moor Facial Products, see Pg. 9**

Competitors will begin by reviewing the model's health history to confirm the suitability of the treatment. This is followed by a thorough cleansing and detailed skin analysis (see pg. 8) to accurately assess the skin's condition, then an exfoliation to prepare the skin. Next, a Moor Spa professional serum and peel-off masque will be applied <https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=nMSgXVIYQSA> during which the competitor will provide a relaxing scalp massage to enhance the model experience. After removing the masque, competitors will select and apply appropriate finishing products, leaving the skin refreshed, glowing, and rejuvenated.

Creative Makeup: Galaxy Theme

In this fantasy makeup competition, competitors will create an original, Galaxy-themed makeup design covering 75% of the model's face, neck, and décolleté, extending two inches below the collarbone. Competitors may use the makeup medium of their choice (excluding airbrush) and are encouraged to be creative in their interpretation of the theme. The remaining 25% of the area may be left bare or minimally blended for balance, but the focus should be on showcasing detailed artistry and imaginative design within the themed area. All hygiene and sanitation procedures must follow the Skills Canada Makeup Station & Hygiene Standards (see below)

3D embellishments and any other decorative additions on the face, neck, or décolleté are not permitted. This includes rhinestones, gems, glitter pieces, or any raised or non-makeup materials. Competitors must use their own makeup products. The final look should demonstrate advanced technical skill, creativity, and thoughtful execution across the entire design area.

All large equipment may be brought into the competition area on April 8th, 2025, between 3:00 p.m. and 4:00 p.m. Once the competition has begun, no additional equipment or supplies may be brought in to assist the competitor.



Makeup Sanitation

Procedures: How To

- Make sure all brushes and implements are clean and disinfected prior to the service.
- All cream/liquid products must be dispensed using a clean spatula onto a clean palette.
- Powder makeup products may be sprayed with 70% alcohol prior to use for disinfection purposes.
- Liquid eyeliners/paint pens etc. cannot be disinfected, if being used the product must be new (in packaging) and either disposed of or given to the model afterwards.
- Do not double dip mascara wands as these are one time use only.
- Alcohol activated cream paints may be used as the alcohol will disinfect the product each time it is sprayed.

Design Area & Coverage Requirement

Required makeup area:

face, front of neck, upper chest (décolleté) extending ~2 inches below collarbone. Shoulders and arms are not included.

Coverage Requirement:

At least 75% of the design area must be visibly covered with Galaxy-themed makeup; 25% may remain bare or softly blended for balance.

Acceptable: Full face + partial neck/décolleté, or both sides of face/neck with small bare chest section.

Not acceptable: Small decorated sections (e.g., only eyes/forehead) leaving large bare patches.

- Competitors must achieve $\geq 75\%$ coverage
- Blend/fade zone below collarbone must look intentional and complete

Prohibited Materials

Professional makeup mediums (including wax, latex, gels, creams, body paints, cosmetic glitter) are permitted.

Stick-on embellishments and non-makeup items are **strictly prohibited** on face/neck/décolleté. This includes rhinestones, gems, sequins, pearls, feathers, foil, craft glitter, or other raised materials.
